

The Crucible is a play by the American playwright Arthur Miller, and is filled with examples of irony throughout the play to build suspense and create anxiety. Situational Irony: John Proctor says that his wife can't lie only for her to come out and lie about why Abigail was dismissed from their service. This is ironic because he had an affair with Abigail. "Fenimore Cooper's Literary Offences" does kick off with a doozy, however: "Cooper's art has some defects." What did Mark Twain say about being respectful to others? The irony of Mary's statement, "I have no power," lies in the fact that her interrogation leads to the arrest of John Proctor. The example of verbal irony is when John Proctor admits in open court that he is an adulterer. Arthur Miller used three kinds of irony, and they are dramatic, situational, and verbal irony. What is ironic about Mary Warren's statement? One of the many examples of dramatic irony is when Elizabeth is asked to tell the truth about John being an adulterer. Dramatic Irony: Elizabeth denies that her husband committed adultery to try to protect him but she doesn't know that he already confessed to it. Hale quits because he realizes many people are dying with no true cause. One example of situational irony is when Elizabeth Proctor is questioned about whether or not her husband had an affair with Abigail Williams. The situational irony is a contrast between what is expected to happen and what actually does happen. Then she is taken away because she lied in court and John tells her he had already confessed as she is being taken out. John Proctor did indeed have an affair and Elizabeth also knew because she discharged Abigail from her service after finding about the affair. What is the irony in The Crucible Act 1? When John does try to prove Abigail is lying, he ends up confessing that he committed adultery with Abigail. The verbal irony occurs when someone states one thing and means another, and is often recognized as sarcasm. He states, "if Jacobs hangs for a witch he forfeits up his property that's law! And there is none but Putnam with the coin to buy so great a piece" ( Miller 89). His feeling is that he as already confessed before God and that means more to him than their written statement because he does not believe another man has the right to judge him. Considering how the Puritans preach against sin and view willful wrongdoing as a one-way trip to hell, that a reverend should encourage people to lie to save their earthly lives is deeply ironic.
